*Prayer is simply talking to God.*
- 5. Love One Another: Luke 10:25-37**  
*We live and give generously inside and outside of our community.*
- 6. Keep Meeting: Acts 2:37-47**  
*We identify what the early church did and follow their pattern.*
- 7. Lord's Supper: 1 Corinthians 11:23-29**  
*We constantly remember that Christ has redeemed us through his death.*
